

As part of the UN Light Year Celebrations the department of basic science and



A honesty shop under the initiative of CSE Students has been started and it has been playing a vital role in developing student's honesty in business and transactions.


Seminar on Technical Writing Skill - Professor Harvey Starkman, Seneca College, Canada


