1. Introduction

1.1 The prospectus contains the rules and regulations applicable for selection and admission to Engineering Courses for the academic year 2015-16 and includes the procedure for admission to management seats other than NRI seats meant for the children/dependents of NRIs.

2. Criteria of Eligibility for Admission for B. Tech Courses

2.1 Academic:-

Pass in Higher Secondary Examination of the Board of Higher Secondary Education of Kerala or an examination recognized equivalent thereto with at least 45% marks in Mathematics, Physics and chemistry/equivalent subjects put together or equivalent grade put together for admission to Management seats. However students admitted in merit allotment should have 50% marks in Mathematics separately and 50% marks in Mathematics, Physics and chemistry/equivalent subjects put together or equivalent grade. Candidates belonging to OBC/OEC category are eligible for relaxation of marks as per government norms.

Candidate should qualify in the entrance examination conducted by the Commissioner of Entrance examination **KEAM 2017 or KEE 2017** conducted on **May 29, 2017** by the Kerala Self Financing Engineering Colleges Management Association.

2.2 NRI Admission

5% of total seats are reserved for admission to dependents of NRI's. They need not to write or undergo any sort of entrance examination

2.3 **Age:**-

Applicants should have completed 17 years of age on 31 Dec 2017. No relaxation of age will be allowed.

2.4 Nationality:-

Candidates must be Citizens of India.

3. How to Apply

- 3.1 Formal Application forms for admission can be obtained from the college office in person or can be downloaded from the website of the college www.mangalam.ac.in.
- 3.2 The duly filled in application along with attested copies of necessary documents shall be submitted directly or by post so as to reach the college office on or before the prescribed date.
- 3.3 Applications submitted to the college should be complete in all respects. Candidate should fill all the items in the Application form in his/her own handwriting.

3.5 Copies of Certificates/Documents to be submitted along with the application

- a) $12^{th}/10^{th}$ certificate in proof of the date of birth
- b) Mark list of qualifying examination and entrance examination
- c) In case where the candidates claim any sort of reservation or special consideration, documents to prove such claims along with income certificate.
- d) KEAM2017 Score sheet/Data sheet
- 3.6 Applications not accompanied by documents in proof of claims of reservation will not be considered in such categories. Documents/Certificates furnished after submission of the application will not be entertained under any circumstances. Late and incomplete applications will be rejected.

5. Procedure for Selection

5.1 Preparation of common Merit list and Allotment of seats:

Subject to any orders that may be passed by the courts, admission will be on the basis of marks obtained for Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry/equivalent subjects in the qualifying examination.

- 5.2 Reservation shall be as per principle as contemplated in G.O.(P)208/66 Edn dated 02-05-1966, G.O.(MS)No.95/08/SCSTDD dated 6-10-2008 and as modified from time to time by the Government.
- 5.3 Furnishing the false information/particulars would result in the forfeiture of the candidature as well as cancellation of admission to the course if admitted and in addition, will attract the relevant provisions of criminal law of the land.
- 5.4 Merit list for the admission will be published in the website/college notice boards. Selection will be in the order of merit through open counseling. The date for counseling will be published in the website, website and college notice board.

6. Admission

- 6.1 For genuine reasons, management will have the right to deny admission to any candidate even if otherwise eligible and such reasons will be recorded and informed to the student.
- 6.2 Candidates are advised to visit the website of the college from 1st June 2016 onwards and appear for interview and admission as notified therein. No separate communication will be sent to the candidate on this account.
- 6.3 Selected candidates for B.Tech courses shall take admission at the appointed time and date in the College after paying the tuition fee and other fees to be paid failing which the offer of admission will be cancelled. The fee to be paid at the time of admission in management seat is as given here under:

7.1 Tuition Fee Waiver Scheme
